

**Instructions for the Authors of International Conference
on Futuristic technologies in Control systems &
Renewable Energy (ICFCR 26) at MES College of
Engineering, Kuttippuram, 23-24 September 2026**

Camera Ready Paper Submission- Instructions for Authors

Before camera-ready paper submission, the authors are required to go through the IEEE paper submission policies available at this link:

Specific instructions regarding camera-ready submission to ICFCR 2026 are as follows:

Step 1: Final Camera-ready paper preparation

Authors must complete the registration process before uploading the camera-ready paper and e-copyright form as per the stipulated final dates.

1. Please follow the IEEE two-column A4-size standard conference format for preparing your final manuscript. For more details, please visit the IEEE Templates page: [IEEE Templates](#).
2. Insert the Copyright details in the first page of the paper at bottom left as given below: For papers in which all authors are employed by the US government, the copyright notice is: U.S. Government work not protected by U.S. copyright, For papers in which all authors are employed by a Crown government (UK, Canada, and Australia), the copyright notice is: 979-8-3195-1963-4/26/\$31.00 ©2026 Crown. For papers in which all authors are employed by the European Union, the copyright notice is: 979-8-3195-1963-4/26/\$31.00 ©2026 European Union, For all other papers the copyright notice is: 979-8-3195-1963-4/26/\$31.00 ©2026 IEEE

3. Revised Version: Revise your paper based on reviewers' comments/suggestions. Authors are responsible for ensuring that the comments given by reviewers and meta-reviewers are addressed in the final manuscript. The reviewer's comments are made available on the same Microsoft paper management site: [Reviewer Comments](#).
4. Use good-resolution images and diagrams. The resolution should not be too low or too high. A resolution of 300 dpi is generally recommended. Do not paginate (don't insert page numbers) your paper. Use the fonts and font sizes strictly as prescribed in the IEEE conference template. Check for any further typos and grammatical errors, and verify the tables & figures for correct captions. Ensure that all reference papers are listed and cited exactly as per the standard IEEE template. Ensure the quality of everything by printing the paper and thoroughly cross-checking it against the IEEE standard template.
5. The maximum allowable pages in the camera-ready paper are 6 pages. A maximum of 2 additional pages is permitted at an extra page charge. The additional payment required for extra pages is Rs.500/page for Indian authors of all categories and USD 20/page for all categories of foreign authors.
6. The camera-ready paper should exhibit low similarity with previously published literature. Typically, a total similarity index below 30%, excluding references, is acceptable, provided that the similarity with any individual source does not exceed 10% and appropriate correct citations are given for the sources. Verbatim reproduction of text, equations, tables, figures, or images from other sources is not permitted unless properly quoted, cited, and used with the necessary permissions.
7. The manuscript must be submitted in PDF (.pdf) format with a maximum file size of 5 MB. The PDF file should not be encrypted or password-protected, and all fonts must be embedded in the document.

Step 2: PDF eXpress check

Before Creating a PDF, Proofread your source document thoroughly to confirm that it will require no revision.

Creating your PDF eXpress Account

Log in to the [IEEE PDF eXpress® site](#)

First-time users should do the following:

1. Create Account
2. Enter the following:
 - **70898X** for the Conference ID
 - your email address
 - a password
3. Continue to enter information as prompted.

An Online confirmation will be displayed and an email confirmation will be sent verifying your account setup.

Previous users of PDF eXpress need to follow the above steps but should enter the same password that was used for previous conferences. Verify that your contact information is valid.

Step 3: Renaming your PDF File for Submission

The certified PDF file received from IEEE PDF eXpress will be assigned the filename 0123456.pdf. Authors are required to rename this file according to the following naming convention before uploading it to the submission system.

PIDXXX.pdf, where XXX is the paper ID of your paper in Microsoft CMT. For example, if the CMT paper ID is 10, the file received from PDF Express should be renamed to PID010.pdf.

Authors are required to upload only those papers that have successfully passed the IEEE PDF eXpress compliance check to the Microsoft CMT system, and only after completing the conference registration in the appropriate category.

Step 4: Camera-ready Paper Submission

After completing Step 3, submit the paper through the Author Console in Microsoft CMT. Please note that the title of the paper must remain the same as in the originally submitted version. Under no circumstances should the author list or the order of authors be changed in the final manuscript.

Step 5: Submission of the IEEE electronic copyright form

IMPORTANT: Authors must ensure that all co-authors are registered in Microsoft CMT using their correct names and contact email addresses. The IEEE electronic copyright (e-copyright) system retrieves author information directly from CMT. Any discrepancy between the author names in CMT and those listed in the manuscript may result in the paper being excluded from the conference proceedings and not being uploaded to IEEE Xplore.

Submission of the e-copyright form is a one-time process and cannot be modified once completed. In case of any errors, authors must contact IEEE directly, as the conference organizers are unable to make corrections.

After uploading the final camera-ready paper (which must have successfully passed the PDF check in IEEE PDF eXpress), click on the “Submit IEEE Copyright Form” link available in the Microsoft CMT Author Console. This will redirect you to the IEEE Electronic Copyright Form (eCF) website to complete the copyright submission.

Once the IEEE Electronic Copyright Form and the required copyright agreements have been completed, you will be able to download the finalized IEEE Copyright Form. The corresponding author will also receive a copy of the completed form via email.

Please upload the downloaded copyright form to the same page in CMT using the upload option (or the “Drop files here” area). The corresponding author may submit the copyright form on behalf of all co-authors of the paper.
